Description: Two hills for sledding in middle of the park.

Difficulty level: Intermediate

Warming shelter: Yes

Description: Sledding hill and ice-skating rink.

REID GOLF COURSE

Difficulty level: Beginner to Intermediate

Warming shelter: Yes

Description: Two nice, smooth hills with few trees or obstacles face each other adjacent the club house.

WANICK CHOUTE PARK

Sherwood

Difficulty Level: Beginner to intermediate Warming Shelter: Yes

Description: Small hill on north end with several runs.

ART LECKER PARK

Grand Chute

Distance: 1.6 miles

Trail type: Classic, Skating

Description: Mostly flat trails wind through woods and open prairie.

GORDON BUBOLZ NATURE PRESERVE

Distance: 8.5 miles Trail type: Classic

Description: A 775-acre wildlife preserve. including 8.5 miles of groomed ski trails, Bubolz also provides ski rentals.

GREENBUSH TRAILS

Northern Kettle Moraine

Trail type: Classic, Skating

Description: Five loops of ski trail extending 13.5 miles through the State Forest. Warming shelter and night skiing.

HIGH CLIFF STATE PARK

Sherwood

Distance: 5.7 miles

Trail type: Classic, Skating

Description: Three trails—0.9 miles, 1.4 miles, and 3.4 miles—are beginner to intermediate level and groomed for traditional skiing.

MEMORIAL PARK

Combined Locks

Distance: 2.6 miles

Trail type: Classic

Description: Six short trails through undulating terrain, and the natural beauty of Garner Creek make this a memorable trip.

PLAMANN PARK

Outagamie County

Distance: 3.5 miles

Trail type: Classic **Description:** Groomed cross-country trails

wind through a 250-acre park, which also includes a snowshoeing trail. Portable restroom available.

REFORESTATION CAMP

Brown County

Distance: 19 miles

Trail Type: Classic, Skating

Description: Reforestation Camp in Brown County offers a wide variety of flat and hilly terrain, a warming shelter, light concecssion and night skiing.

REID GOLF COURSE

Appleton

Distance: 1.8 miles

Trail Type: Classic, Skating

Description: Multiple trail loops with many small hills. The clubhouse serves snacks and hot chocolate-check hours for availability.

ART LECKER PARK

Grand Chute

Distance: 1.25 miles

Description: Mostly flat with some small hills through bottomland forest and open grassy

CALUMET COUNTY PARK

Distance: 2.2 miles

Description: Park (and patronize) Fish Tail Bar & Grill bar in winter when access road is closed

HARTMAN CREEK SP

Waupaca

Distance: 6 miles

Description: Three trails wind through Hartman Creek State Park- groomed for fat-tire biking in winter.

LC ISLAND TRAILS

Little Chute

Distance: 3 miles

Description: Three groomed fat-tire biking trails accessible off of Heritage Parkway Trail just south of Heesakker Park adjacent the

Distance: Short trail

Description: Access is from the Scheig Center parking lot. Trail runs primarily through grassy areas and is mostly flat

Distance: 1-2 miles

Description: Wooded trails along Garner

Distance: 1.2 miles

Description: Small rolling hills in 25-acre

REID GOLF COURSE

Distance: 1.4 miles

Description: Trail skirts perimeter of the golf course

REFORESTATION CAMP

Brown County

Distance: 6 miles

Description: Reforestation Camp in Brown County provides four short fat-tire bike trails. Access is off Reforestation Road across from NEW Zoo.

WOODLAND PRAIRIE PARK Fox Crossing

Distance: Approximately 1.5 miles **Description:** Description: Recently constructed trails will be groomed for fat-tire biking. Small parking lot off Shady Lane just east of County Road CB.

FRITSCH PARK

Warming shelter: Yes

Description: Park includes a skating rink and sledding hill.

JENNERJOHN PARK

Greenville

Warming shelter: No

Description: Ice rink open till 10 p.m. Adjacent sledding hill.

Description: A hockey rink with boards and an open skate rink with no boards. Lights for night ice-skating and restrooms. Large natural pond at base of hill.

Warming shelter: No

Description: Large rink with outdoor seating for changing skates. Park also has a nice sledding hill, as well as trails through the woods and pedestrian bridge to Island Park.

MEMORIAL PARK

Neenah

Warming shelter: Yes

Description: Ice rink and sledding hill.

PIERCE PARK Appleton

Warming shelter: No

Description: Two ice rinks, one located underneath the pavilion. Restrooms.

WASHINGTON PARK

Neenah

Warming shelter: Yes

Description: Ice rink and sledding hill.

GORDON BUBOLZ NATURE PRESERVE

Distance: 8.5 miles

Description: Two snowshoe trails: a one-mile loop and a three-mile loop.

Rentals: Yes, see website for information on rentals

MEMORIAL PARK

Neenah

Distance: No formal marked trails

Description: Informal trail network through open fields and woods in this 105-acre park. Rentals: No

PLAMANN PARK

Outagamie County

Distance: 1-mile trail

Description: Out and back loop that starts

at Park Office parking lot.

Rentals: No

Appleton

Distance: Multiple loops available **Description:** Informal trail network. Access from Riverview Gardens Community Center.

HIGH CLIFF STATE PARK

Rentals: No Sherwood

Distance: Multiple loops

Description: Allowed throughout the park

except on XC ski trails.

Rentals: Limited availability, call for details.

1000 ISLANDS NATURE CENTER

Distance: Approximately 5 miles

Description: Snowshoe and XC ski trails in the upper woods area. Rentals: Yes, call for details.

HECKRODT WETLAND

RESERVE

Menasha Distance: 1/2 - 3/4 miles

Description: Flat terrain through forested

wetland area. Rentals: Yes, see website or call ahead for information.
